Long story short....




Get some wood, this time I took a kind of easy one.

Simple and local spruce, easy to cut, however, it'll not last very long out there in the rain and sun.

You may get it from a log cabin builder quite cheap.

Dimensions: approx. 120cm height and 40cm diameter

Sketch the basic shape, don't worry to take some ideas from internet!

Change tooling and use your grinder to get the surface smooth and even











You may use such a cutting tool to make feathers and patterns. Please take care, it's a quite dangerous tool. Make sure your grinder has a kick back stop feature.
